OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

Yes, I know - it seems far too early to mention Christmas BUT, it's time to be thinking about shoeboxes again!! If you'd like to fill a shoebox for a child who lives in poor conditions abroad here is an opportunity to do so. Find a shoebox, cover box and lid separately with Christmas wrapping paper and fill the box with small gifts (unwrapped). There will be leaflets in church which give ideas of gifts suitable to put in your box; please read leaflet carefully as there are some gifts not suitable and they will be taken out at the warehouse e.g. liquids, chocolate and war related toys (toy guns etc). You can choose whether you'd like your box to go to a boy or girl and there are 3 age categories to choose from too. Please add £3 per box for transport costs. Maybe you'd like to get together with someone else and share the cost of gifts and transport costs. Also, there is a DVD available to borrow showing videos over the last few years, of delighted children receiving their gifts, or you can read some stories of people who received a shoebox when they were a child and the impact it made on their lives, by going online to Operation Christmas Child 2015 (https://www.samaritanspurse.org.uk/what-we-do/operation-christmas-child) and clicking on shoebox stories which I'm sure you'll find really interesting and very touching. If you do decide to do a box, please return your box to church by Sunday 8th November.
